# Governor Sununu and Pro Football Hall of Fame Join NH Healthy Families for Virtual Youth Summit on Suicide Prevention

The New Hampshire event will include the involvement of area youth and bring awareness to mental health issues and suicide prevention – issues that are even more relevant to teenagers that are dealing with additional stress during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Youth participants from around the state will have a chance to hear personal stories from **Governor Chris Sununu**, New England Patriots Hall of Famer **Andre Tippett**, Coach **Ryan Day**, former UNC Women's basketball player, **Iman McFarland**, and Pro Football Hall of Famers **Darrell Green**, **Anthony Muñoz**, **Aeneas Williams**. These community leaders and sport legends will offer up their real life experiences through overcoming challenges in the face of adversity and deliver a message of hope to all young adults.
