Anesthesia Billing Tip Sheet

PRODUCT ELIGIBILITY	CLAIM FORM INSTRUCTIONS
Solution of the second state of the second sta	 CRNA: Must bill charges on their own claim as the rendering provider and bill with their own NPI. Bills on a CMS-1500 claim form Claim denials will result if CRNA bills charges on the same claim as the Anesthesiologist.

Commonly used modifiers:

AA	Anesthesia services performed personally by anesthesiologist
QZ	CRNA performed services without medical direction
QY	Medical direction of one CRNA by an anesthesiologist
QK	Medical direction of two, three, or four concurrent anesthetic procedures involving
	qualified individuals (e.g. CRNAs or residents)
QX	CRNA performed services under the medical direction of an anesthesiologist

Commonly used CPT Codes:

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01960	Anesthesia for vaginal delivery only
01961	Anesthesia for cesarean delivery only
01962	Anesthesia for urgent hysterectomy following delivery
01963	Anesthesia for cesarean hysterectomy, without any labor analgesia/anesthesia care
01967	Analgesia/anesthesia for planned vaginal delivery
01968	Anesthesia for cesarean delivery, following neuraxial labor analgesia/anesthesia
01969	Anesthesia for cesarean hysterectomy, following neuraxial labor analgesia/anesthesia

Reimbursement for CRNA Services:

The Plan will utilize the anesthesiology base unit(s) and conversion factor values when calculating CRNA payment rates.

• Modifier **QX** must be used by the CRNA to indicate services that were medically directed by a physician – reimbursement will be 50% of the base procedure code reimbursement rate

• Modifier **QZ** must be used by the CRNA to indicate services that were without medical direction of a physician – reimbursement will be 100% of the base procedure code reimbursement rate
