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## JAFFREY-RINDGE MIDDLE SCHOOL AND NH HEALTHY FAMILIES PARTICIPATES IN NATIONAL NO ONE EATS ALONE DAY

**Bedford, NH** – (June 18, 2021) – A positive prevention initiative designed to promote inclusion among students was celebrated in New Hampshire this year on June 17, 2021. Jaffrey-Rindge Middle School students participated in the outdoor event sponsored by NH Healthy Families.

Representatives from NH Healthy Families hosted the outdoor event in honor of <u>No One Eats Alone® Day</u>, created by the nonprofit <u>Beyond Differences<sup>TM</sup></u>. More than 300 students participated in activities designed to teach them about social isolation and the negative impact it can have on health and academic performance. Social isolation affects millions of students and has been identified as a precursor to bullying, self-harm, and community violence. Amid the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, promoting mental health has gained increased importance, as students deal with the additional stressors from the pandemic and quarantining. Through *No One Eats Alone*, students have shown that if they are given the tools, they will stand up for others as empathetic and caring activists, not passive bystanders.
