SUD Rendering Provider Enrollment Billing Requirements Change October 5, 2022

NH Healthy Families would like to remind all Substance Use Disorder (SUD), Opioid Treatment Program (OTP), and Peer Recovery providers of the upcoming requirements issued by the NH Department of Health & Human Services.

Federal regulations at 42 CFR 455.410 require all professionals providing Medicaid services to be enrolled as participating providers. Federal compliance also requires providers to include the National Provider Identifier (NPI) for rendering providers on Medicaid claims (HCFA-1500, Block #24-J and UB-04, Block #76).
