Goal Setting and Documentation: The SMART Format for Writing Treatment Plans (2.5 CEUs) Tuesday, July 22, 2025 10:00 AM - 12:30 PM EDT

In this presentation participants will learn why strong documentation is important, the importance of connecting documentation and medical necessity criteria. Participants will acquire skills related to how this can be accomplished using SMART format. Participants will also be provided with opportunities to apply what they have learned via hypothetical case examples.

Behavioral Health Screening Tools for Providers (2.5 CEUs) Thursday, July 31, 2025 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM EDT

This training is composed of evidence based validated Integrated screening tools used to evaluate persons at risk for substance use disorders, behavioral health illness and possible co-morbidities. These evidenced based tools can be used across multiple physical health, substance use and behavioral health domains utilizing integrated care practices for screening BH and co-morbidities.
