



## **Pharmacy Preferred Drug List Changes- Addendum**

Effective 7/14/2025, NH Healthy Families will move the following medications to non-preferred status on the Preferred Drug List. Prior authorization will be required. Please consider transitioning patients to preferred alternatives.
