QuitNow-NH connects members with a trained Quit Coach who can help them build a personalized quit plan, manage cravings, and choose the right nicotine replacement products to support their success.

Quit Coaches are available from 7 AM to 1 AM so members can make coaching sessions fit into their life schedule. If they prefer texting, those who are 25 years and older, text "Start" to 300500; 18-24, text 36072. A coach will text them for free and help them create a quit plan that will work best for them. They can also sign up for free motivational text messaging.

By enrolling in **My Life My Quit**, teen participants receive: Five, one-on-one coaching sessions usually scheduled every 7-10 days. Coaching helps teens develop a quit plan, identify triggers, practice refusal skills and receive ongoing support for changing behaviors, Selfhelp and educational materials designed for teens, with input from teens and Additional support by phone, by text message or by online chat.
