







## NH Healthy Families, Ambetter from NH Healthy Families, and Wellcare Musculoskeletal Management Program Provider Education Webinars

In an effort to continue promotion of quality improvement for services provided to NH Healthy Families (Medicaid), Ambetter from NH Healthy Families (Exchange), and Wellcare (Medicare) members, effective February 1, 2024, NH Healthy Families, Ambetter from NH Healthy Families, and Wellcare is expanding its existing partnership with National Imaging Associates, Inc. (NIA)¹ to provide the management and prior authorization of non-emergent Musculoskeletal (MSK) procedures including: outpatient, interventional pain management services (IPM); and inpatient and outpatient hip, knee, shoulder, lumbar and cervical spine surgeries.
