The Hospital commits to participate in the New Hampshire Foundation for Healthy Communities/Health Research & Educational Trust (HRET) Hospital Improvement Innovation Network (HIIN) initially from September 28, 2016 to September 27, 2018. There may be the possibility of an optional third year from September 28, 2018 to September 27, 2019. The HRET Hospital Improvement Innovation Network will continue to expand the previous CMS work to improve quality and safety. We commit to working toward a 20 percent reduction in all-cause patient harm and a 12 percent reduction in 30-day all-cause readmissions.

As outlined in the federal regulations, the Hospital believes that the above mentioned program utilizes evidence-based initiatives to improve health care quality through the collection, management and analysis of patient safety events that reduces all cause preventable harm, prevents hospital readmission, or improves care coordination.
