JAFFREY-RINDGE MIDDLE SCHOOL AND NH HEALTHY FAMILIES PARTICIPATES IN NATIONAL NO ONE EATS ALONE DAY

Bedford, NH – NH Healthy Families recently sponsored the Jaffrey-Rindge Middle School student celebration of *National No One Eats Alone* Day, a positive prevention initiative designed to promote inclusion among students.

Representatives from NH Healthy Families hosted an assembly in honor of *No One Eats Alone Day*, created by the non-profit <u>Beyond Differences</u>TM. More than 300 Jaffrey-Rindge students participated in activities designed to teach them about social isolation and the negative impact it can have on a student's health and academic performance. The students then engaged in a simple act of kindness at lunch – making sure no one is eating alone by sitting with students who they didn't know. They were given ice breaker topics to spur conversations and highlight their commonalities.

Social isolation affects millions of students and has been identified as a precursor to bullying, self-harm and community violence. Students have shown that if they are given the tools, they will stand up for others as empathetic and caring activists, not passive bystanders.
