Physicians are significantly more likely to die by suicide than the general population, and an estimated 300 physicians die by suicide in the United States every year. The COVID-19 pandemic has exacerbated the stress, burnout, and fatigue already felt by many physicians, providers, and other healthcare professionals balancing the duty of caring for patients with concerns for their own health and wellbeing. Despite these challenges, many do not seek treatment or support for fear of stigma or professional repercussions.

This training provides specific Suicide Safer Care techniques to help support your primary care providers and team members through systematic and organizational approaches to address suicide risk and prevent deaths by suicide among employees. Join this webinar to learn about the scope of the crisis and how organizations can better support staff through effective suicide prevention and postvention strategies during and beyond the COVID-19 pandemic.
